# Free School Meals DID YOU KNOW?

School Meals are FREE to all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Your child may also be entitled after Year 2!

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they'll be eligible to receive them until they finish the phase of schooling (primary or secondary) that they're in on 31 March 2025.

Free School Meals (FSM) also provides extra funding to your school, you can register your child for FSM to receive any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they aren't entitled to Working Tax Credit and are an annual income (grossed as by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £10,100
- Working Tax Credit (maximum £1,400) - it pays more than any other benefit for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
